Who can participate?

Young people between 18-25 years who would like to spend the 2 weeks from 04-17/08/2008 with young people from all of Europe and to support together a meaningful and fascinating project.

What means "Lidice"?

Lidice was a little village in Czechoslovakia during the time of the occupation by the German „Nazis“. In 1942, its inhabitants have been the victim of a brutal act of revenge by the SS. With the "Lidice-Camp", the LidiceHaus in cooperation with the "Volksbund Deutsche Kriegsgräberfürsorge e.V." want to give a clear signal of remembrance.

Who are the organizers?

The LidiceHaus is a training centre for young people which deals with political youth work, promotes encounters and solidarity, self-determination and justice. In terms of organisation, it is supported by the "ServiceBureau Jugendinformation".

The "Volksbund" is a humanitarian organisation. It works in commission of the government of the Federal Republic of Germany and is a state-approved institution of youth welfare service. It is the only War Graves Commission which practises its own Youth- and Schoolwork true to the motto "Work for peace".

What is it about?

- We plant a rose-garden as a symbol for "Lidice"
- We construct an „experimental path“ which enables people to learn something about Lidice with all their senses
- We work on war grave and memorial sites, we will search for traces and organise a commemoration ceremony
- We discuss about current issues such as war and violence, right-wing-extremism etc.
- Of course, there will also be enough time for getting to know each other, free-time, sports, discovering Bremen and the north-ern-german region

Other important things ?

- The languages of the camp are German and English. You should have knowledge of one of those languages.
- Concerning the charges: You have to finance your trip by yourself. Unfortunately, we have to ask for a little participation fee which is 100,00 € (for the "old" EU-countries) and 50,00 € (for the "newcomers"). This charge is then "all inclusive": board and lodging, seminar- and free-time activities, insurance etc.
